

The City of Côte Saint-Luc is represented herein by Côte Saint-Luc Aquatics (CSLA). The objective of this Code of Conduct is to ensure that all participants in CSLA, including parents/guardians assume their respective responsibilities to create a positive and rewarding environment.

CSLA works in conjunction with and adheres to the guiding principles of the following organizations: Quebec Education, Sport & Leisure – Parents’ Code of Etiquette (http://www.mels.gouv.qc.ca/fileadmin/site_web/documents/publications/CodeEthiqueParent_MELS.pdf);

With this in mind, I agree to abide by the following:

1. CSLA will not tolerate the use of violence, abusive or profane language or inappropriate behavior at any time.
2. During swim competitions SNC Rules SW 2.1 CSW 2.1.6.5 and 2.1.6.6 will be enforced.
3. CSLA parents will display sportsmanship, dignity and be a positive role model at all times. Parents will not yell in a derogatory fashion at any swimmer, meet officials, coaches or any other parent.
4. Parents are not allowed on deck during practice time and swimming competitions. Parents are limited to the spectator galleries. If a parent wishes to communicate with a coach arrangements will be made outside of practice/competition times away from pool deck.
5. Coaches will coach. Parents are spectators and are not to coach, yell instructions to the team or any swimmer from the stands/spectator galleries. Cheering of all swimmers is encouraged.
6. Parents will respect and abide with all coaching staff and official’s decisions.
7. If parents have questions or concerns regarding a parent or coach they will pursue them through the Aquatics Manager or the Swim Team Development Coordinator to be dealt with in the appropriate manner.
8. CSLA expressly forbids the consumption of alcohol by participating parents/chaperones/volunteers during the hours of competition while at the meet venue or accommodation in the presence of swimmers.
9. CSLA expressly forbids the use of any illicit substances, including hallucinogenic substances or any non-prescribed drugs during practices or at any competition.
10. CSLA is required to sign entries to events governed in accordance to the Canadian Anti-Doping Program and the World Anti-Doping Code. As such CSLA expressly forbids noncompliance to the above mentioned codes.
11. CSLA expressly forbids the willful damage, defacement or destruction by any person of personal property or of any facility or property thereof.
12. Parents may not recruit or solicit CSLA families in order to further their own interests using a CSLA email distribution list.

I also agree that failure to comply with the aforementioned rules and guidelines I (and my guests) will be subject to disciplinary action that may include, but is not limited to the following:

- Verbal or written warning
- Removal from the facility (during practice or competition event)
- Parental suspension (duration ranging from 2 weeks up to lifetime ban)
- Swimmer suspension (duration ranging from 2 weeks up to lifetime ban)
